BY-LAW NO. 25 of 2016

"A By-Law to Amend the Schedules of By-Law No. 39 of 2009 for the Prohibition of Heavy Trucks on Certain County Highways"

WHEREAS under the authority of s. 35 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, council for The Corporation of the County of Lambton (the "County") passed By-Law No. 39 of 2009, the "Prohibition of Heavy Trucks By-Law";

AND WHEREAS the County wishes to amend and update the Schedules of By-Law No. 39 of 2009 to add certain highways;

AND WHEREAS the County sought public input with respect to Heavy Truck traffic on County Road No. 4 (Petrolia Line);

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the County of Lambton enacts as follows:

- That Schedule 2 of By-Law No. 39 of 2009 is amended by designating the portion of County Road No. 4 (Petrolia Line) between 100 metres East of County Road No. 26 (Mandaumin Road) and County Road No. 21 (Oil Heritage Road) as a Prohibited Highway 2;
- 2. That prohibitions applicable to the portions of highways listed and described in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 of the By-Law attached hereto are hereby confirmed.

THIS BY-LAW read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 5th day of October, 2016.
